The YD Coach must have a love of children and the ability to see one's inherent potential. The selected candidates will have experience managing dynamic programming, staying current with administrative responsibilities, demonstrate their motivation and ability to execute the objectives of the Organization. In addition, they will use flexible and creative techniques to connect the participating kids with the intended subject matter.
